- That Girl Scouts of Greater Mississippi Council Inc. has the right to cancel this agreement at any time.
- **To abide by the following rules:**
 - ❖ Cars may be used to transport equipment to sites, but may not be used for riding from place to place in camp during your stay.
 - ❖ No outdoor fires may be built except in designated fire rings/fire places. Camp stoves may be used outdoors or in screened buildings, but may not be used in tents/cabins.
 - ❖ No tobacco products, alcohol, or drugs may be brought onto the camp property.
 - ❖ Group should remove all garbage from site and place in provided receptacles.
 - ❖ No open flame lanterns (kerosene, candles, white gas, etc.) may be used inside tents/cabins.
 - ❖ Adults are responsible for supervision of children; knowing their whereabouts at all times.
 - ❖ Natural resources should not be damaged or destroyed in any way.
 - ❖ Your site must be left clean and ready for use by the next group when you check-out.
