Helping Hands	Construction Work
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace worn tarps in each cabin of every unit. • Clear and mark all trails beginning to end. • Measure lake depth and make weighted depth markers and "gates" (anchored markers) for canoe/kayak games • Establish "wildlife feeding/viewing stations w/ signage along the trails • Create trail around lake w/ environmental "stations" along the way. • Clean up and provide resources for the Nature Center • Paint cabins (inside and out), pavilions, and inside of Craft House (Former Troop House). • Repair/Replace Camp Sign at front gate • New signs for camp • Establish new fire ring at Dogwood • Scrap and re-paint bathroom doors, Walls and floor in Civitan Pavilion • Re-vamp totem pole at Main Campfire Ring • Plant grass in primitive camping area • Clean Carpet in Program Center • Paint Bankston House (inside and out) • Repaint Signs in front of Luggage Area. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Re-establish the Upper Camp Road. • Build a free-standing puppet theater (wooden tri-fold or PVC pipe and drape kind-NOT table top size) • Benches for fire rings in units (seating for approx. 40 in each unit • Build covered information center in main camp • Replace boards in main fire ring seating area. • Close in bottom level of Jo Reicker lodge (Canoe Shed), install lights and doors, and repair stairs in front and back of cabin • Repair cabin stairs in units • Repair bricks around main camp flag pole • Build platforms for tents in the primitive camping area • Replace floor in Dining Hall, Craft House (Former Troop House), Jo Reicker, Infirmary and Program center (tile only). • Repair and clean out chimney in Craft House • Replace doors for dining hall and for all cabins in the units. • Replace rails on ramp at Dining Hall • Complete remodel of Ranger's Cabin • Install ramps on bathhouses and pavilions in units. • Build a handicapped accessible pier for Lake Ingram. • Remove and replace sheetrock in Main Bath House. • Repair water supply to primitive camp site.
